Attachment 1 - NFPA 1403

The following is a synopsis of the requirements under NFPA 1403 to be utilized by students and instructors.

Personnel participating in Live Fire evolutions should familiarize themselves with Chapter 6 (Non Gas Fired Training Center Buildings)

6.1.1 Prior Training

Student must receive prior FF1 training in following

- (1) Safety
- (2) Fire Behavior
- (3) Portable Extinguishers
- (4) Personal Protective Equipment
- (5) Ladders
- (6) Fire Hose, appliances, and streams
- (7) Overhaul
- (8) Water Supply
- (9) Ventilation
- (10) Forcible Entry

6.2.16 Pre burn walkthrough

6.4.1 thru 6.4.6 Safety Officer on all Live Fire evolutions

6.4.7.3 Personnel assignments

1 instructor per crew – max 5/1 ratio

1 instructor to each backup line

6.4.10 Building evacuation plan with evac signal (A&M uses airhorn)

6.4.14 No persons shall play role of victims

6.4.17 thru 6.4.17.6 NFPA PPE, work uniforms

6.5 Instructor qualifications, responsibility
