

# **EMERGENCY SERVICES TRAINING INSTITUTE**

The **Texas Fire Officer Program** is a comprehensive fire officer training program offered by TEEX Emergency Services Training Institute to all Texas fire service personnel. The program consists of NFPA 1021-based Fire Officer courses (Fire Officer I, II, III/IV).

**Prerequisites:** Fire Officer I – Firefighter II & Fire Instructor I Fire Officer II – Fire Officer I Fire Officer III/IV Combination – Fire Officer II & Fire Instructor II

Certification: <u>SFFMA</u> Fire Officer I Fire Officer II <u>TCFP / IFSAC</u> Fire Officer I Fire Officer II <u>ProBoard</u> Fire Officer I Fire Officer II Fire Officer III Fire Officer IV



### Courses are eligible for American Council on Education (ACE) credit.

**Location:** Courses will be conducted at one of the hosted training sites in Texas or the U.S., at one of the TEEX regional training sites, or at the world-renowned Brayton Fire Training Field in College Station, Texas.

- WHY .......... To increase one's knowledge of various management and leadership abilities to effectively lead and manage fire service personnel both on and off the fire ground.

## **COURSE INFORMATION**

### Rural Volunteer Fire Department (VFD) Assistance Program (HB 2604)

- Training tuition grants under this program will be provided up to a maximum of \$85 per day, not to exceed \$595 per trainee per school.
- Training tuition grants are limited to a maximum of \$6,000 per department per school.
- The maximum amount of Training Tuition assistance a department

## Texas Intrastate Fire Mutual Aid System (TIFMAS)

- Training Tuition grants under this program will be provided up to a maximum of \$85 per day, not to exceed \$595 per trainee per school.
- Training tuition grants are limited to a maximum of \$6,000 per department per school.
- The maximum amount of Training Tuition assistance a department may receive in a fiscal year (September through August) is \$12,000.
