PURPOSE: To provide guidance and consistency for Harris County Fire, EMS, and Rescue personnel in recognizing and reporting suspicious activities, behaviors, or materials relating to possible criminal or terrorist activities, which may observe during the course of their normal duties.

What Should I Consider Suspicious?

Criminal Activity & Potential Terrorism Activity

- ◆ Breach/Attempted Intrusion
- ◆ Misrepresentation
- ◆ Theft / Loss / Diversion
- ◆ Sabotage / Tampering / Vandalism
- ◆ Cyber Attack
- ◆ Spoken or Written Threat
- ◆ Aviation Activity





Potential Criminal or Non-Criminal Activity

- ◆ Eliciting Information
- ◆ Testing or Probing Security
- ◆ Photography
- ◆ Observation / Surveillance
- ◆ Materials Acquisition / Storage
- ◆ Acquisition of Expertise
- ◆ Weapons Discovery
- ◆ Sector-Specific Incident



What Should I Do?

Be Part of the Solution

DO...

-  Contact local law enforcement if obvious or immediate risk to life and public safety
-  Gather information about individual(s) without drawing attention to yourself
-  Identify license plates, vehicle description, names used, languages spoken, ethnicity, etc.
-  **Submit an SAR Report**

DO NOT...

-  Put you or your crew in undue danger
-  Just let it go...
