- —Volunteer Fire Department (VFD) Assistance Program (HB 2604)
 - Training tuition grants under this program will be provided up to a maximum of \$125 per day, not to exceed \$650 per trainee per school.
 - Training tuition grants are limited to a maximum of \$6,250 per department per school.
 - ◆ The maximum amount of Training Tuition assistance a department may receive in a fiscal year (September through August) is \$12,500

- —Texas Intrastate Fire Mutual Aid System (TIFMAS) for Career Fire Departments
 - Training tuition grants under this program will be provided up to a maximum of \$125 per day, not to exceed \$650 per trainee per school.
 - Training tuition grants are limited to a maximum of \$6,250 per department per school.
 - The maximum amount of Training Tuition assistance a department may receive in a fiscal year (September through August) is \$12,500
