HB2604 & TIFMAS Grant Approved Training

**WHO** ..... **All members of volunteer, paid, or part-paid fire departments of cities and industries who need or wish to obtain state or national certification in accordance with NFPA 1021, Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications.**

**WHY** ..... **To increase one's knowledge of various management and leadership abilities to effectively lead and manage fire service personnel both on and off the fire ground.**

## COURSE INFORMATION

### **Rural Volunteer Fire Department (VFD) Assistance Program (HB 2604)**

- ♦ Training tuition grants under this program will be provided up to a maximum of \$125 per day, not to exceed \$650 per trainee per school.
- ♦ Training tuition grants are limited to a maximum of \$6,250 per department per school.
- ♦ The maximum amount of Training Tuition assistance a department may receive in a fiscal year (September through August) is \$12,500.

### **Texas Intrastate Fire Mutual Aid System (TIFMAS)**

- ♦ Training Tuition grants under this program will be provided up to a maximum of \$125 per day, not to exceed \$650 per trainee per school.
- ♦ Training tuition grants are limited to a maximum of \$6,250 per department per school.
- ♦ The maximum amount of Training Tuition assistance a department may receive in a fiscal year (September through August) is \$12,500.
