National Fire Academy Conducting Risk Reduction by Company Officers

Course Description:

This NEW 6-day NFA course seeks to improve the skills of Company Officers (COs) to lead and conduct risk-reduction activities within the service area of their station/community. The course is both for the CO who is currently engaged in risk-reduction activities and the CO who desires to lay the foundation to start community risk reduction.

This course is about how a local fire station can plan, implement, and evaluate risk-reduction activities to benefit the citizens it serves.

Students learn that a broader approach to fire protection involved multiple interventions, and when all are applied to a specific community risk issue, a difference is likely to occur, reducing risk for the citizens. Students also learn that by reducing the community's risk, the risk for firefighting forces is also reduced.

Students will have the opportunity to develop/simulate a plan to lead station personnel to recue risks in their own service area.
